Aitutaki

Bubbles Below is a locally owned and operated business. Your instructor - Onu, is an experienced diver who will ensure you have an unforgettable diving experience! He knows all the best diving spots around Aitutaki and you will see the beautiful natural and undamaged parts of the Cook Islands waters.

After a short boat trip, you will arrive at one of the many great diving sites Aitutaki has to offer, and once in the water you can expect to see huge schools of spotted eagle rays, massive green turtles, napoleon wrasses, and moray eels. Apart from the common tropical reef fish you will often encounter oceanic species like tunas, trevallies & barracudas. There are some beautiful drop-offs, walls and coral gardens, fish feeding spots where you can let the fish eat coconut out of your hand, and some great swim spots and caves. If you are traveling from May through to October with a little bit of luck you may get to see the humpback whales on a shared or private Whale Watching Tour.

Bubbles Below has a new purposely built Dive & Whale Watch aluminium vessel which is 12.5 meters. A typical 2-tank diving day takes around 4 - 5 hours and during the surface interval you will have hot chocolate and biscuits.

Diving is usually done at a depth between 20 to 30 meters, where visibility is clear. The water temperature around Aitutaki is warm, between 26 - 31 degrees Celsius. Bubbles Below can take you out for an intro dive and if your companion isn't up for diving he or she is welcome to follow on the boat to do some snorkeling whilst you are making your bubbles.

After the diving you head back to the dive center where the crew will take care of the cleaning of equipment and you can just sit back and talk about the dives you've done, while enjoying some home-made toasties.

Bubbles Below cater their diving trips to your experience and always do a safety check with every diver, keep a maximum depth of 30 meters and plan their dives according to your level of comfort. During all dives the boat is manned with a rescue trained crew member.

Diving with Bubbles Below is about having a relaxed and enjoyable time. You don't have to carry around heavy scuba equipment/tanks or rinse your material after the diving. This is all done by Onu and his fantastic crew.
